Short Title: SUPPORT FEDERAL MARRIAGE AMENDMENT

Summary:

- Urges the United States Congress to pass Senate Joint Resolution 1, known as the Marriage Protection Act, that defines marriage as a union between one man and one woman.

Benefits:

- Eliminates the uncertainty surrounding the definition of marriage.
- Reinforces the traditional family structure in America.

Background:

- Since the beginning of civilization marriage has been the primary social institution all over the world. The definition of marriage has been challenged in recent years and it is time to end the debate and return to its traditional form. SJR 10 urges the United States Congress to pass Senate Joint Resolution 1, which defines marriage as the union between one man and one woman. The constitutional amendment would need to be ratified by three fourths of the nation's state legislatures.
