Lynn Sponsors Resolution for Protection of Seaports

(JUNEAU) – Representative Bob Lynn (R-Anchorage), is drafting a House Special Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs Resolution opposing a contract by the United States with the United Arab Emirates (UAE) for protection of American seaports.
