Sectional Analysis

Section 1. Amends the duties of the attorney general by requiring the attorney general to participate in litigation that affects the management and jurisdiction of the natural resources of the state; requires the attorney general while participating in that litigation to ensure that that management and jurisdiction is not diminished or ceded to others; and permits the attorney general to enter into agreements to fulfill these requirements.

Section 2. Requires that settlements of litigation be consistent with section 1 of the [bill](#).

Section 3. Amends [Alaska Rule of Court Procedure 24\(c\)](#) by requiring notification of the attorney general when the management or jurisdiction of the natural resources of the state may be affected in litigation.

Section 4. Amends [Alaska Rule of Appellate Procedure 514\(f\)](#) in a manner similar to that done in section 3 of the bill.
